## An Encouragement to Pray

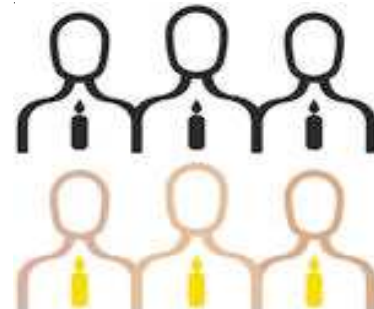
On Wed. Sept. 14th, we will start up our weekly prayer gathering.
